also in southern Alberta.

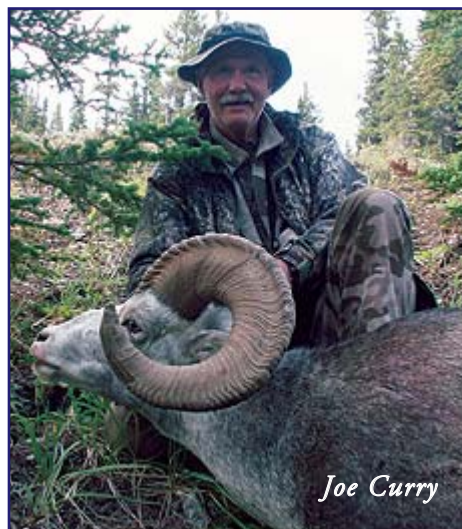
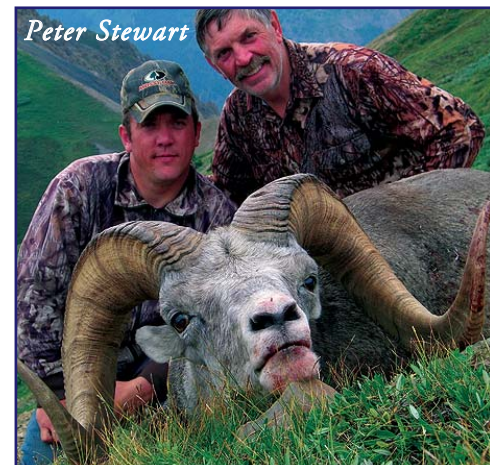
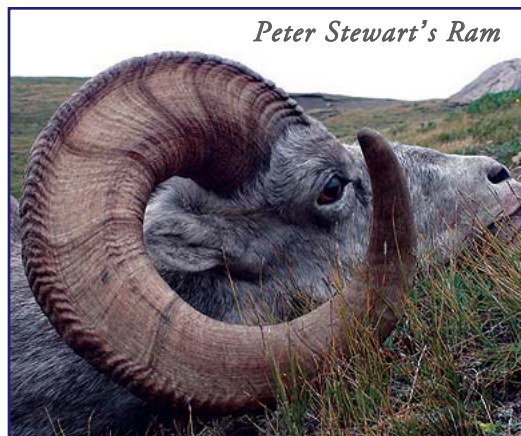
Even though we had hot weather and

Two of our hunters on mixed bag hunts were successful in taking 3 species on one hunt. Jon Lee took a great Ram, Goat, and also a Book Mt. Caribou. Manuel Camacho also took three animals: a huge 39-1/2" Ram, Big Moose, and a Goat.

In October, we moved back to Alberta and started our Mule Deer hunts and the Archery Bighorn hunts.

We had some fantastic hunts for Mule Deer. We have had several mild winters and the Bucks are getting bigger and more plentiful each year.

Our son Chase harvested another large Buck with his Bow as well as a nice Elk.

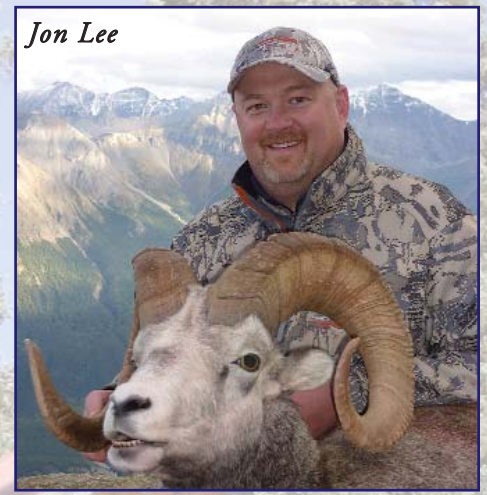
Chase helped me guide Cindy to a big wide Mule Deer buck.

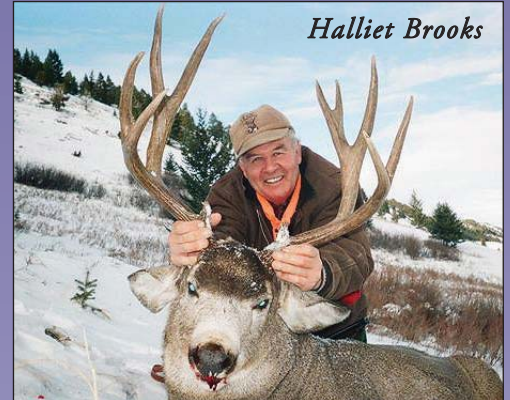

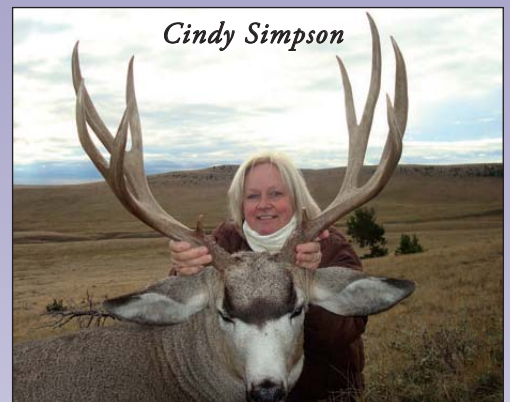
